

RANDOM

HOW TO WIN:

Be the first player or team out of cards by creating random statements using the words from each card you select.

HOW TO PLAY:

- 1 Using the Dry Erase pen, each player should write his/her name on Player's Name cards and place on gameboard. Each player may then write three miscellaneous words on players word cards to try and stump their opponents. Place your words next to the appropriate category face down on the opposing teams side.
- 2 At games beginning each team pulls two cards from each category. Do not pull from And, But & Or, Players Names, or Directional Cards (these are for game play).
- 3 A spin of the dial lets a player know what stack to draw from for opposition cards. If there is no opposing card on second line; then the player goes to the first line of Game Cards and pulls a card.
- 4 "Random Statements" derived from the words in a player's trough must be thrown down in 30 seconds.
- 5 If a player cannot put words into a statement within 30 seconds, then his team must continue to spin again and hold all cards not laid down in a Random statement.
- 6 After a "Random Statement" is laid down; players have the chance to consider if it is truly a random statement or they may call "Bull Shit".
- 7 After discussion the player will either defend his statement and gain a discard, If declared a non-Random statement or "Bull Shit" the team must continue to hold those cards and spin again.
- 8 All statements and words must be in English and anything goes as far as interpretation of said words supplied by players.
- 9 Any words tense may be applied: past, present, or future. Prepositions are a given and can be added in and random statement. And, But and Or, Players Names and Directional cards once used can be placed on the bottom of the pile to recirculate during game play.
- 10 First Team out of cards wins the round and the losing team continues to hold cards for the next round.
